Welcome to Flipping Ninja Math©!

As you might've heard by now, I've made several thousand dollars in the flipping business and it has treated me extremely well. In this document, I really want to educate you on how EASY it can be to hit income or money goals through flipping things.

I always tell people, making \$500 a month is EXTREMELY easy.

It's so easy it almost hurts. Hopefully, once I'm done showing you the ropes (and once you finish going through The Flipping Ninja Blueprint© -- you'll have no problem not only making at LEAST \$500 in a month, but making \$500 in a weekend will become a normal thing for you.

I've made \$500 in 45-60 minutes probably over a dozen times through flipping things.

It might sound crazy or unrealistic if you're coming from the corporate, employee & paycheck world where you get paid per hour.

But this game is completely different. It's all just a numbers game. And once you really "crack the code" which I will show you, you won't believe *how easy it is to make money quickly* through flipping things, with VERY little time. All gold from here. 😊

How To Make \$500 Flipping Things

Profit Per Sale	X	How Many Sales Needed	=	Desired Amount of Money
\$ 5	X	100 sales	=	\$500
\$ 10	X	50 sales	=	\$500
\$ 20	X	25 sales	=	\$500
\$ 40	X	13 sales	=	\$520
\$ 50	X	10 sales	=	\$500
\$ 60	X	9 sales	=	\$540
\$ 100	X	5 sales	=	\$500
\$ 150	X	4 sales	=	\$600
\$ 200	X	3 sales	=	\$600
\$ 500	X	1 sale	=	\$500

To understand Flipping Ninja math, in the above example, the first column (Profit Per Sale) is the amount of profit you made or would make per sale.

So for example, let's say I came across Coffee mugs at a thrift store for \$1.

I knew I could sell them each for \$6, resulting in a \$5 profit.

I would need to make 100 sales for that specific product or profit amount, to get to my goal of making \$500.

On the other hand, as you go down the chart, you'll notice that **the higher you go, the fewer sales you have to make.**

For example, let's say I got really good at selling Yamaha keyboards, and make \$100 profits on each flip, that means I just need to sell 5 keyboards to make \$500 bucks. Get it?

You can also combine sales with different profit amounts.

For example, let's say I flipped a couch and made a \$200 profit on it. I just need \$300 bucks to get to my goal of \$500. So here are some things I can do:

- ❖ I can flip 3 things that give me a \$100 profit each ($\$100 \times 3 \text{ items} = \300)
- ❖ I can look for something that will give me a \$10 profit, then flip 30 of them ($\$10 \times 30 \text{ items} = \300)
- ❖ I can buy something, re-sell it for \$20 more than what I bought it for (very easy, you almost don't have to do anything), 10 times. ($\$20 \times 10 \text{ items} = \200). Then I can try and flip 2 other things that each give me a \$50 profit ($\$50 \times 2 \text{ items} = \100). I just made a total of \$300.

You get the point. I really want you to start thinking this way (you'll be pulling out your calculator a lot running these numbers soon, trust me) because that'll ultimately determine how much money you'll make, and how motivated you will be. Once you see how easy it is, you just follow the numbers. This is after all a numbers game (an EASY one at that).

I have created the following charts for your convenience for higher profit goals. Same rules apply.

How To Make \$10,000 Flipping Things

Profit Per Sale	X	How Many Sales Needed	=	Desired Amount of Money
\$ 5	X	2,000 sales	=	\$10,000
\$ 10	X	1,000 sales	=	\$10,000
\$ 20	X	500 sales	=	\$10,000
\$ 40	X	250 sales	=	\$10,000
\$ 50	X	200 sales	=	\$10,000
\$ 60	X	170 sales	=	\$10,200
\$ 100	X	100 sales	=	\$10,000
\$ 150	X	70 sales	=	\$10,500
\$ 200	X	50 sales	=	\$10,000
\$ 500	X	20 sales	=	\$10,000
\$ 1,000	X	10 sales	=	\$10,000

Note: Because the flipping business is a profits and marketing world, keep in mind, **you can make these sales as fast as you want.**

That means if you can manage to flip 20 things that all give you a \$30 in 2 days, you just made \$600 in 2 days.

Or another example, let's say in just 3 weeks, you:

1. Flip 5 dressers and make \$200 profits on all 5
2. Flip 3 cell phones and make \$50 on all of them.
3. Flip an acoustic guitar and make a \$120 profit on it
4. Flip 3 Yamaha keyboards and make \$100 profit on each

In only 21 days, you will have made a total of \$1,570.

Not too shabby for only putting in a couple hours of work to pull it off.

Or... flip 5 cars, making a \$500 profit on each.

$$5 \text{ cars} \times \$500 \text{ profits} = \$2,500$$

OR

$$5 \text{ cars} \times \$1,000 \text{ profits} = \$5,000$$

And so on.

Now here's the secret to it all...

You can spend 60 minutes making \$500, or you can spend 60 minutes making \$50...

The time doesn't matter. The skill sets, and knowing what to look for and how to market, does matter.
